PODCAST RECORDED AND PRODUCED BY PEOPLE INCARCERATED IN CA PRISONS LAUNCHES SEPTEMBER 23

(BAY AREA) - *Uncuffed* is a new podcast made by people behind bars in California prisons. The producers, who are incarcerated, share intimate stories taking place within the walls of Solano State Prison and San Quentin State Prison. Each episode will feature one of those stories, accompanied by conversations among the incarcerated producers about the larger themes found within the stories they produce.



"This podcast is vulnerable and personal. If you can see the humanity in us, you can see the humanity in everyone," say the producers of *Uncuffed*.

The producers make this show in collaboration with KALW public radio. KALW has led classes in audio production inside California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation prisons since 2013. Since then, KALW has aired over 60 stories produced inside the walls, and the work has been recognized with a number of journalism awards.
